



- Original abstract available?**  
\*Reference should always be made back to the original abstract when preparing an encore
- Is the original abstract word/character count still appropriate?**  
Check word or character count, for encore Congress requirements
- Congress guidelines followed?**  
\*During edit and review, check Congress guidelines. If available, a medical writer, the freelancer should provide the link to guidance needs changing. The submission website should also be checked for additional information
- Title of encore abstract**  
\*Do Congress guidelines indicate that changes are required e.g. shortened title, capitalized title, removal/inclusion of acronyms
- Authors**  
\*Are all happy to submit this encore?
- Author Affiliations the same**  
\*Are these the same as in the original abstract?
- Translations needed?**  
\*What language is the submission in? Will this affect word count? Typically foreign languages have word counts 10 -25% longer than in English.
- Figures added or subtracted?**  
\*Are figures allowed in the encore submission? Does their inclusion affect the word/character count? Do figures /tables need removing, together with cross-reference to them in the text?
- Tables added or subtracted?**  
\*Are tables allowed in the encore submission? Does their inclusion affect the word/character count?
- Subheadings needed?**  
\*What subheadings are required in the encore, according to the congress guidelines: introduction, methods/materials, results, conclusion or other?
- Text positioning**  
\*Is all text positioned in the correct section of the encore?
- Copyright permissions**  
\*Are they required? Have they been obtained?
- Author disclosure/confidentiality forms**  
\*Are they required? Have they been obtained?
